Some Rules of Completing Sentences:

1st Conditional Sentence: If + Present Ind. + Future Ind.

For Example: If Jubayer comes, we will play Badminton.

2nd Conditional Sentence: If + Past Ind + Past Conditional

(Sb + would/ Could + V1+ Ob)

For Example: If Jubayer came, we would play Badminton.

3rd Conditional Sentence: If + Past Perfect (Sub+ had + V3+ ob) +

Perfect Conditional (Sb+ would have/ Could have + V3 + Ob)

For Example: 1. If Jubayer had come, we would have played Badminton.

- 2. If he had tried more, he could have done better.
- 3. If she had worked hard, she could have achieved the top position in the class.

Rules regarding 'Since'

Present Tense (Present Ind + Present Perfect) + Since + Past Indefinite Tense.

It is/has been long **since** I met.

Many years have passed **since** <u>I met.</u>

- ** Many years have passed since I visited my hometown.
- ** It is many days since we met our friends.
- ii) Past Ind + since + Past Perfect (Sb + had +V3 +OB)

For Example: It was many days since we had met our friends.

Many years passed since we had met each other
