Some Rules of Completing Sentences:

1st Conditional Sentence: If + Present Ind. + Future Ind.

For Example: If Jubayer comes, we will play Badminton.

2nd Conditional Sentence: If + Past Ind + Past Conditional
(Sb + would/ Could + V1+ Ob)

For Example: If Jubayer came, we would play Badminton.

3rd Conditional Sentence: If + Past Perfect (Sub+ had + V3+ ob) +
Perfect Conditional (Sb+ would have/ Could have + V3 + Ob)

For Example: 1. If Jubayer had come, we would have played Badminton.

2. If he had tried more, he could have done better.

3. If she had worked hard, she could have achieved the top position in the class.

Rules regarding 'Since'

Present Tense (Present Ind + Present Perfect) + Since + Past Indefinite Tense.

It is/has been long **since** I met.

Many years have passed **since** I met.

** **Many years have passed** since I visited my hometown.

** It is many days **since** we met our friends.

ii) Past Ind + **since** + Past Perfect (Sb + had +V3 +OB)

For Example: It was many days **since** we had met our friends.

Many years passed **since** we had met each other
