1st Conditional: If + Present Simple + , + Future Simple Example: If you do not do your homework, you will be punished.

2nd Conditional: If + Past Simple + , + Past conditional (S+ would/could + V1 + Ob)

Example: If I had enough money, I would help the poor. If I went for a walk, I would be benefited.

- If I went for a movement, I would be injured.
- If I practiced more, I would win the match.
- If I were a famous person, I would have lots of admirers.
- If I were in Dhaka, I would meet my friends.
- 3rd Conditional: If + Past Perfect (S + had+V3 + ob) + , + Perfect Conditional (Sub+ would have/could have + V3 + ob)

Example: If I had gone for a movement, I would have been injured.

If I had studied more, I would have achieved golden A+.

If they had played very well, they would have won the match.

If I had practiced more, I would have won the match.

If she had studied a lot, she would have passed the exam.

If I had been in Dhaka, I would have met my friends. If I had had lots of opportunities, I would have developed my country.
